CHESTNUT CLASS

LITERACY

This term we will study the books 'The Island' and 'The Boy at the Back of the Classroom' focusing on the theme of refugees and completing both fiction and non-fiction pieces of work

MATHS

We will be focusing on Place Value initially, then looking at the 4 main operations and their methods of calculation- we will also increase our understanding of Fractions

SCIENCE

We have two big questions to answer this term: 'If there were no leaves- would plants still live?' and 'What is the most surprising use of a magnet?'

ART/DT

We will be linking our work from Literacy to Art/DT - as we focus on how we can save the Islander in the most effective way - using our knowledge of construction and different materials

LANGUAGES

We will continue to develop both our spoken and written knowledge of the Spanish language this term - focusing on the topic 'Where do you live?'

GEOGRAPHY
