







Willow class Spring Term 2024



History

Our historians will be stepping back in time into the 17th Century. We will be looking at the events around 1666 including The Great Fire of London, The Plague and the rebuilding of London after. We will compare these events with modern equivalents including the Grenfell Fire and Covid.

Music

We will be learning to play the flute, and exploring a variety of music styles. We will develop an understanding of musical composition, organising and manipulating ideas within musical structures and reproducing sounds from memory.

In R.E we will be pondering the question 'If there is a God why do bad things happened in religious stories?' We will look closely at religious stories thinking about their purpose and moral. We will consider how some character have suffered and discuss any reasons for this. We will also discuss how religion and belief in God can bring comfort in their time of need.

Maths

We will be continuing our journey through multiplication and division by practicing our formal written methods of solving equations. We will then move on to measuring length and perimeter.

Languages

We will be learning important phrases and vocabulary. We will practice our verbal pronunciation through conversations.

Science

Our scientists will be discovering electricity. We will look at how we use electricity daily and discuss the importance of using them safely. We will investigate circuits and investigate how they work and the effect of changing components. We will discuss the difference between insulators and conductors. Following our time studying electricity we will then consider where our electricity comes from and how it is generated. Considering all types of power available we will think about how sustainable they are and how they affect the environment. We will look into the future on how we will power our electrical appliances.

Literacy

We will be learning about different text types. We will study how to write to entertain including writing a story from a different perspective.
